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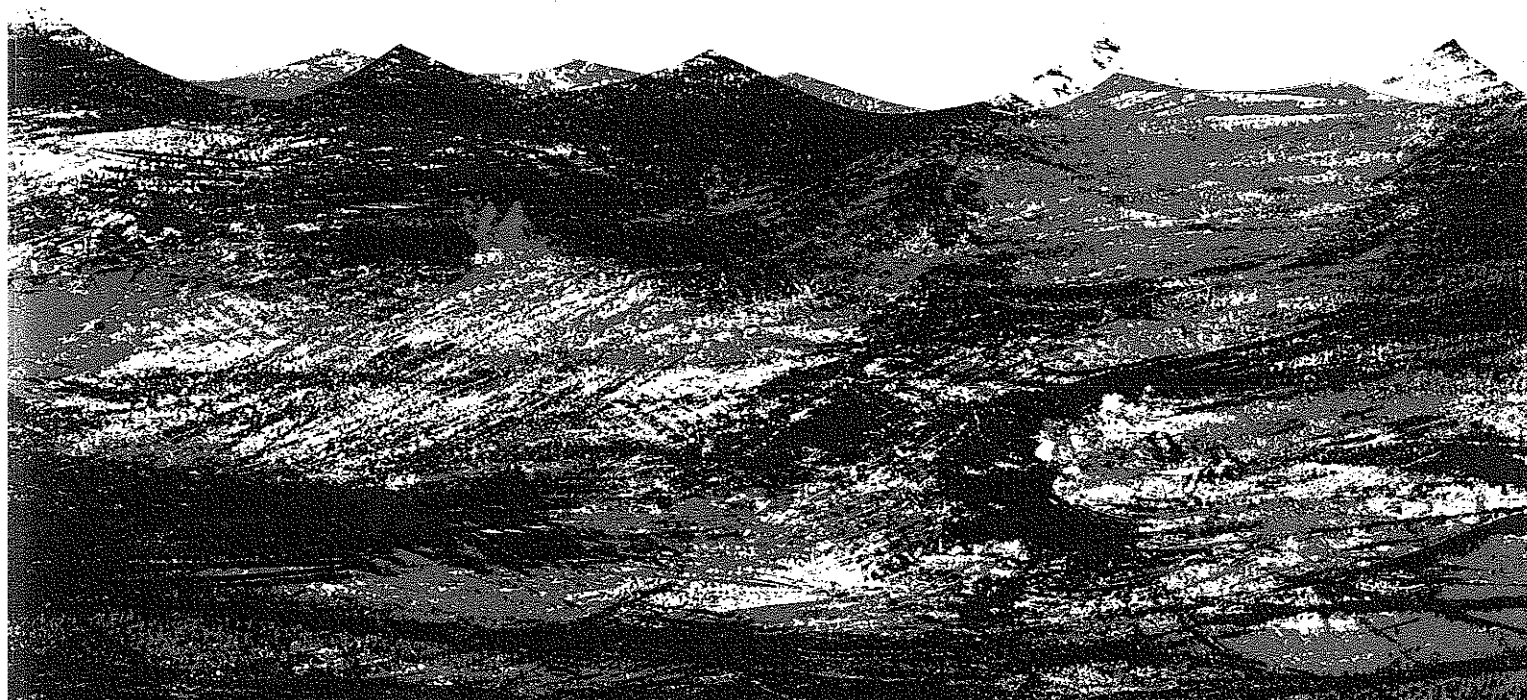

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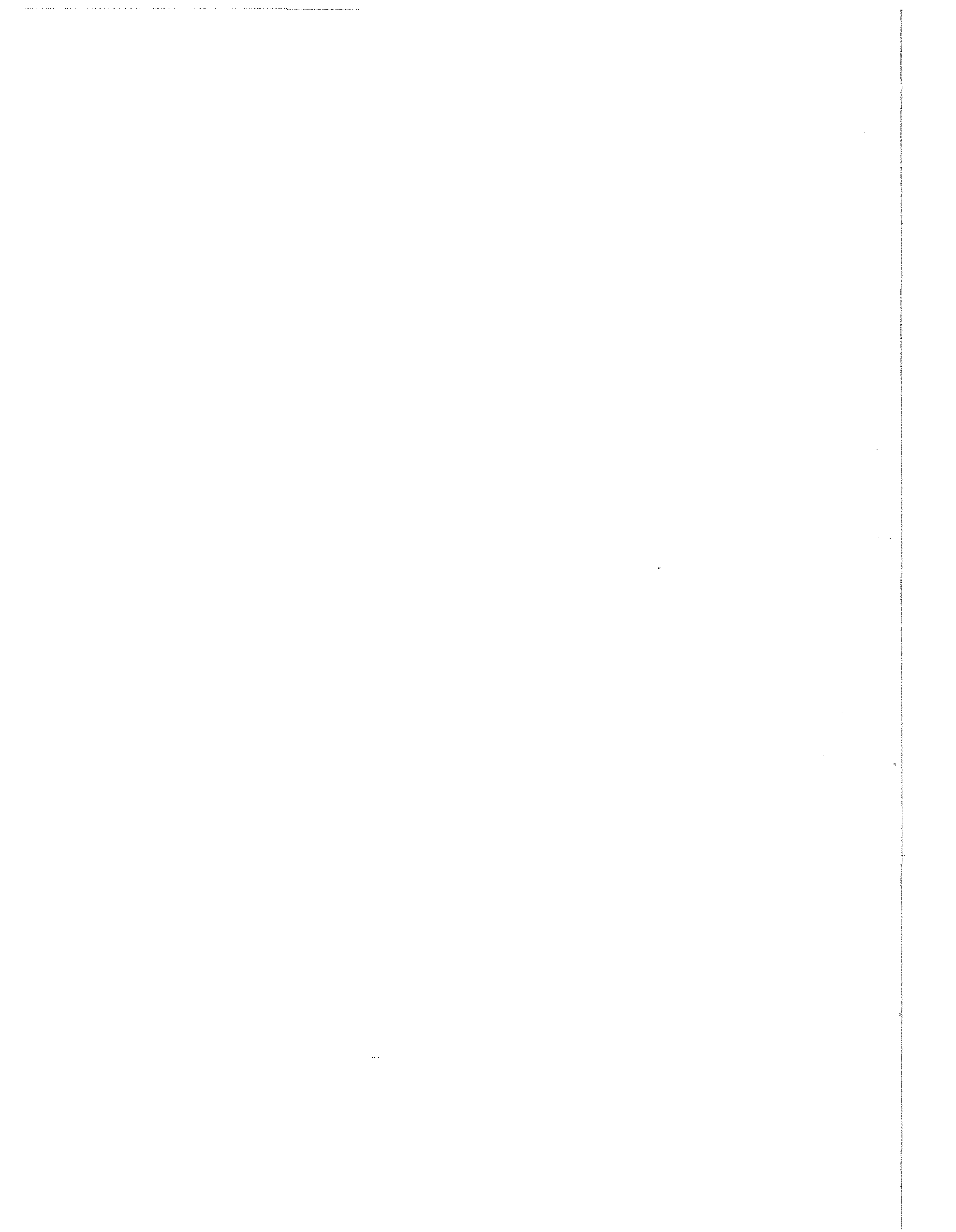

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## INTRODUCTION

This supplement includes ~~130~~ entries published during the years 1834-1972 which were omitted from the main volume of the Bibliography and Index of Wisconsin Ground Water 1851-1972, published by the Wisconsin Geological and Natural History Survey in 1974 as Special Report No. 2. The comments of readers and recent extensive hydrogeologic studies have revealed additional references, mainly of general, historical or marginal values, which would have been difficult to find otherwise. Also cited are the references listed in the Bibliography as unpublished reports which were eventually published after 1972.

The format of the Addendum is the same as that of the main volume. An abbreviation in the upper right corner of each entry indicates where the reference is located in Madison. The references are arranged alphabetically by author. Multiple author listing is provided only for those publications dealing directly with ground water within the state. The names of the junior authors are alphabetically interfiled and cross referenced to the first author (see also). The names of the authors are listed only up to three. If more than three authored the paper, the expression and others is used; all authors are cross referenced. If the authors in a multiple authorship are not known, parentheses are used: (and others).

The references are summarized in several indexes which are differentiated by color: subject index - yellow; county index - green; general index - pink; and chronological index - blue. The indexes refer only to the references included in the Addendum. In order to encompass

all references on Wisconsin ground water which appeared during the years 1834 through 1972, the readers have to also consult the indexes to the main volume. However, as a new feature, a graph showing the chronologically increasing number of references is included for the entire period 1834-1972.

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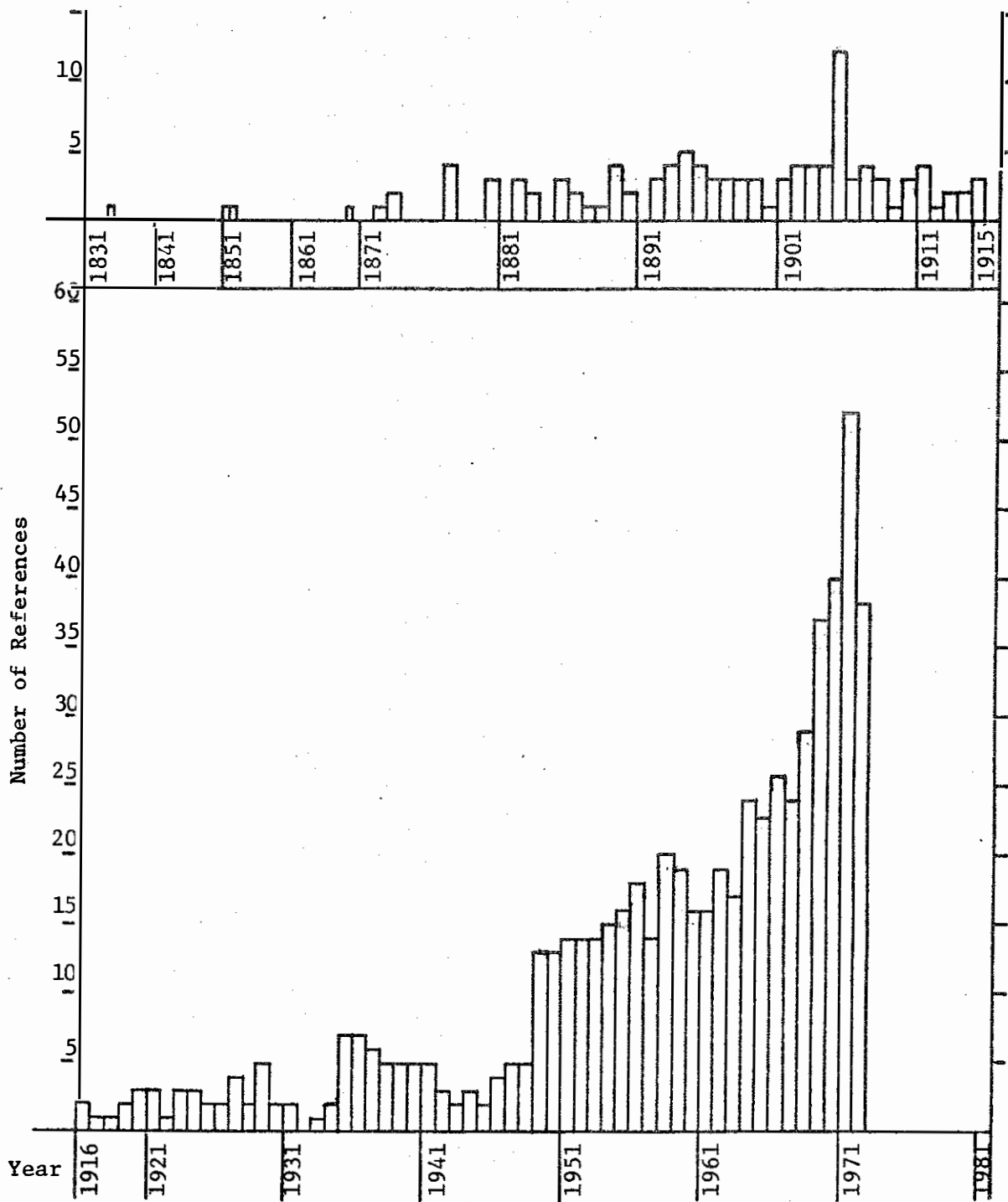

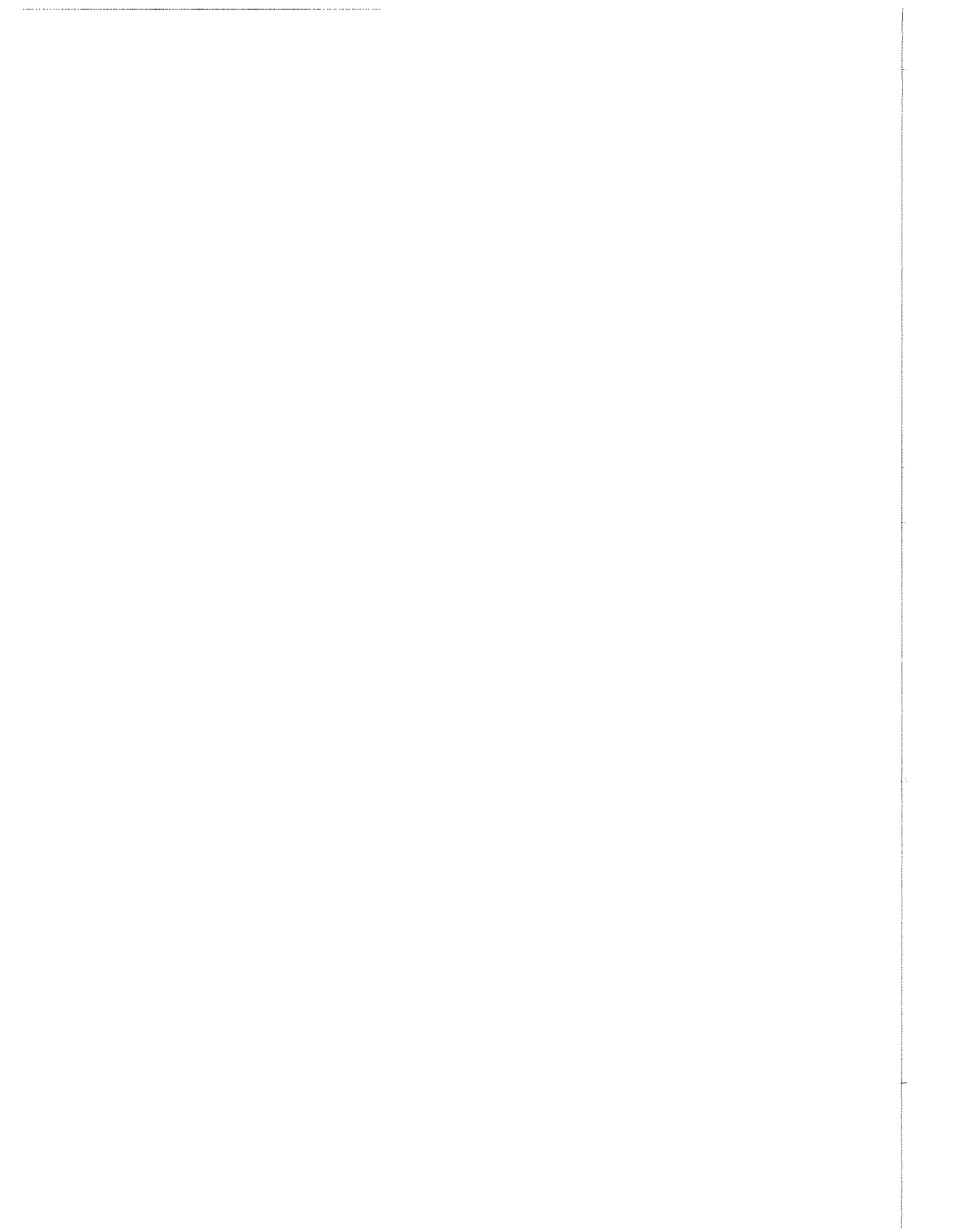

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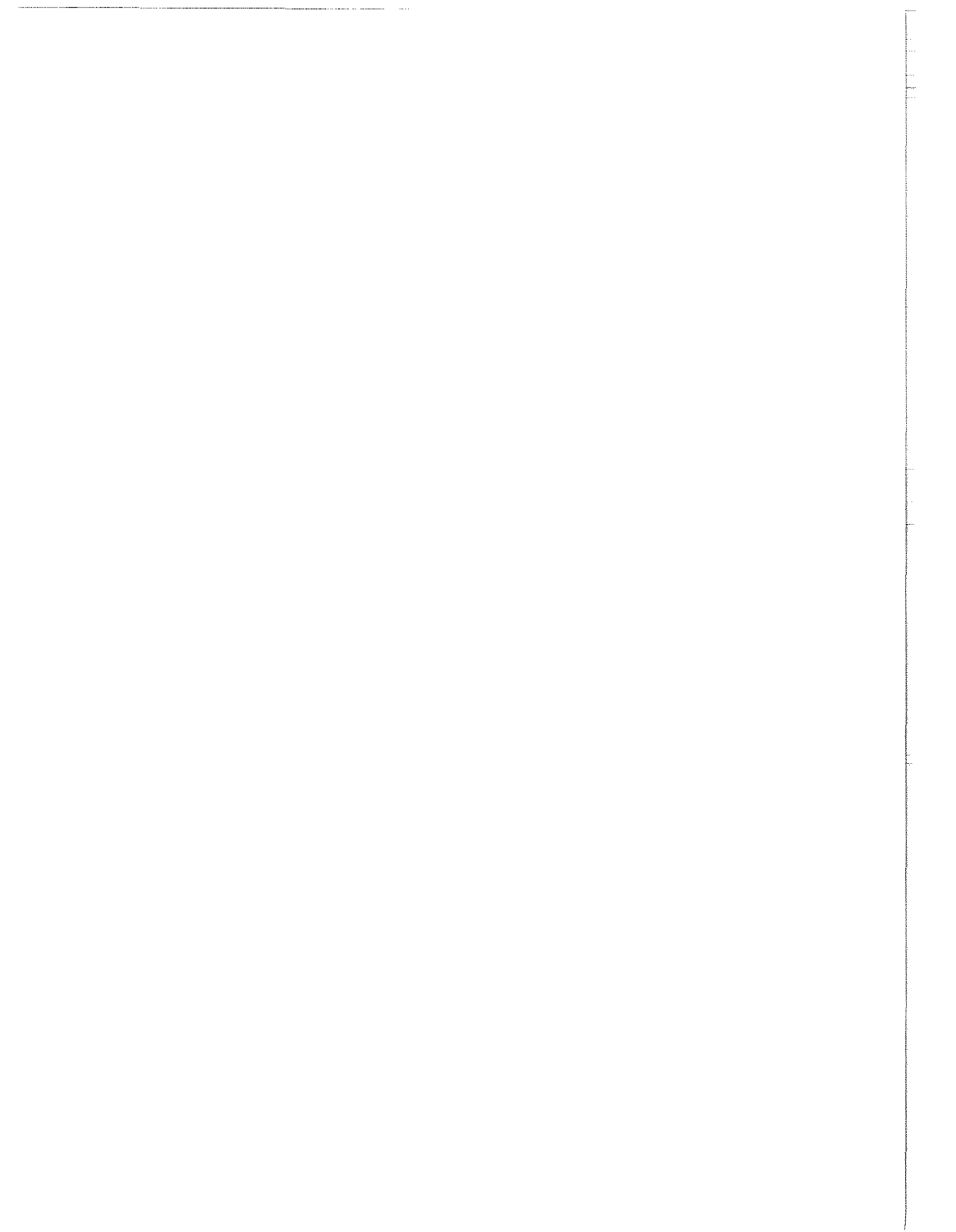
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
